V. ABOUT KMCT COLLEGE OF NURSING

KMCT College of Nursing is established in the year 2008 at Manassery,-P.O, Mukkam, Kozhikode, Kerala with an intake of 50 seats for B Sc. Nursing course. The intake is increased to 70 in the academic year 2021-22 and increased to 90 in the academic year 2023-24. Post Basic B Sc. Nursing is started with an intake of 25 seats in the academic year 2022-23 and M Sc Nursing is started with an intake of 4 seats in two specialties in the academic year 2023-24. The college is accredited with NAAC "A" grade and attached to KMCT Medical College Hospital which is 1200 bedded multispecialty tertiary level NABH accredited hospital. 1. INTRODUCTION

This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to the BSc. Nursing Course, against 50% seats (45 seats) of sanctioned intake of 90 seats and Post Basic BSc. Nursing against 50% seats (13 seats) of sanctioned intake of 25 seats for the academic year 2025-26, in the college, including 15% NRI seats set apart for the dependents of Non Resident Indians

This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of Honorable Courts of law

2. NUMBER OF SEATS AND DETAILS OF RESERVATION

The College is conducting 4 year BSc. Nursing course with an intake of 90 seats and 2 year Post Basic BSc Nursing with an intake of 25 seats. Out of the above, 15 % seats shall be filled up by the candidates from NRI quota and 15% of the seats shall be filled up by the candidates belonging to Muslim minority category as the institution has been granted minority status by the National Commission by the Minority Educational Institutions. The College is a Muslim minority institution. The remaining seats are reserved as per the reservation policy of Government of Kerala.

The seat matrix and details of reservation of seats in management quota are as follows

If sufficient candidates are not available in the NRI category, such seats will be filled up by the candidates from Muslim minority category. If sufficient candidates are not available in the Muslim minority category, such seats will be filled up by the candidates from General merit. The college has applied for increase of seats and if it is approved the seat matrix will be changed as per the reservation policy mentioned above. If the Government is not willing to make allotment to government quota seats, it will be filled up by the management from rank list for the management quota or through spot admission.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

a. BSc. Nursing

Academic:

- (i) Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with Aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 50% marks in English in second Year only are eligible for admission.
- (ii) Relaxation in marks:-
 - (a) Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) in the State of Kerala with total annual family income up to Rs.8 lakhs will have relaxation of

5% marks. The Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates in the state of Kerala need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

- (b) Those candidates claiming relaxation of marks shall produce necessary certificates from the authority concerned. There will be no reservation of seats for SEBC and or SC/ST candidates under Management quota.
- (iii) Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from places other than State of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of interview for admission.

b. Post Basic BSc. Nursing

- (i) Candidates who have passed INC approved General Nursing & Midwifery Course of 3 yrs/3½ yrs duration with aggregate of minimum 50% marks. The students, who have passed physics, Chemistry and biology in 10+2, are only eligible to apply this course. Registration as Nurse & Midwife with Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

Age

- (i) Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2024. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed
- (ii) Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate showing the date of birth / copy of birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission

4. HOW TO APPLY.

Application for admission to B.Sc. Nursing course and Post Basic BSc. Nursing can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website www.kmctnursingcollege.org. Prospectus can also be downloaded from www.kmctnursingcollege.org. However, it will not be available by post. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the applications for the same course submitted subsequent to the first application.

Application Fee:

- (i) The application fee will be Rs.1000/- for all candidates, payable through online. Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of Application fee through online.
- (ii) If the payment is debited and you are not guided to the next stage please inform us to help.kmctcon@gmail.com with your login details or email-id or mobile number, we will provide you the required help within 24Hrs.
- (iii) Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.

Remittance of Application Fee and Submission of Application Form:

The candidates can get the instruction to make the payment and submission of application form in the link “**UG Application 2025-26**” on the website www.kmctnursingcollege.org. No need of submission of hardcopy of application

5. PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

Merit list:

(a) Out of 45 seats, 31 seats (for BSc. Nursing) and out of 12 seats, 9 seats (for Post Basic BSc. Nursing) will be filled by managements from among the online applications on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria by following the reservation criteria as mention in clause 2.1 and 2.2 of this prospectus.

(b) Out of 45 seats 14 NRI seats shall be filled up from qualified students as per G.O (MS) No.243/2014/HRFWD dated 6.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala. The following original documents shall be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Sponsorship Certificate
2. Attested copy of the passport of the sponsor
3. The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.
4. *Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar

*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order No.GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013& KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014,dated 12.06.2014

Resolution of tie while ranking: In the case of a tie in the total marks, the marks in Biology will count. If there is still a tie the marks in Chemistry and Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder will be preferred to the younger.

Validity of the merit list: The published merit list will be valid till _____ or the date up to which the merit list shall be kept alive in terms of instruction/direction of competent authority.

Inclusion in the merit list will not entitle the applicant eligible for admission to the course, unless the applicant satisfy the rules regarding the eligibility for admission and other conditions as laid down in the Prospectus.

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

6. SELECTION BY ALLOTMENT PROCESS

The Allotment Process for Seats in KMCT College of Nursing for which will be made as per the schedule included in the prospectus and allotments will be strictly based on the merit

by following the reservation criteria as mention in clause 2.1 and 2.2 of this prospectus.

Muslim minority Quota: The selection of candidates to Muslim minority community will be based on the merit list prepared by the college. All right of claim for eligibility relaxation or community claim shall be sustained with the required documents at the time of admission.

If sufficient candidates are not available in the list of applicants, the vacant seats will be filled up from the eligible candidates as mentioned in clause No.3.1 and 3.2

7. ADMISSION & PAYMENT OF FEES

The selected candidates will be informed through website of the college.

Fee stipulated by the Fee Regulatory Committee/Govt. of Kerala is as follows:

Caution deposit - Rs. 10,000/- (Refundable)

All other fees due to statutory bodies (KUHS, KNMC & INC) as and when notified later by the College. All the students should be stayed in the hostel for entire duration of the course and all of them should pay the hostel fee as notified time to time. All the students should pay the fees for the remaining years on or before 31st of August of respective years.

The fee mentioned above is provisional and will be subject to change as per the revised order by FRC/Hon'ble Court if any.

Selected Candidates should report for admission on the date as instructed in the website along with the following original documents

- Aadhar card or any other identity proof as provided in the application.
- Mark list of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- Pass Certificate of the candidate at the qualifying examination.
- Document (School Record, SSLC or equivalent) of the candidate to prove his/ her date of birth.
- Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala / CBSE / ISCE.
- A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical

- Officer in Government Service not below the rank of Assistant Medical Officer.
- Course and conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
 - Transfer certificate (TC) from the institution last attended.
 - Document/ certificate required in proof of any benefit claimed in the application for reservation.
 - Certificate of GNM and Nursing Council registration certificate (for Post Basic Applicants)

The candidates selected for NRI quota have to submit the following documents also along with the above documents

1. Sponsorship Certificate
2. Embassy Attested copy of the passport of the sponsor
3. The embassy attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.
4. *Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar

*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order No.GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013& KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014,dated 12.06.2014

Selected candidates have to remit all the fees as mentioned above at the time of admission itself. The fee can be paid by RTGS/NEFT/DD/Netbanking/Online banking. If all the fee as mentioned above is not remitted within the time of admission, the application of the Candidate will be removed from the admission process.

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court"

8. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS.

- (i) Ragging: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in all member colleges. College is committed to abolish ragging in their campuses. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard.
- (ii) Use of Mobile Phone: Use of Mobile Phone by students are not allowed in the campus and hostel of college. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.
- (iii) Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the Controller of admission.

9. REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES
